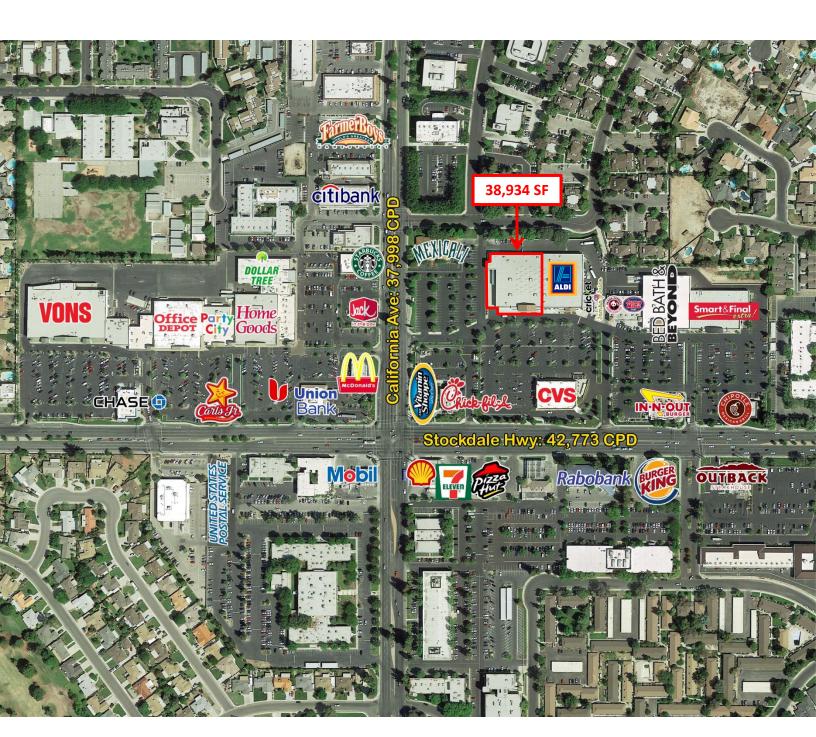

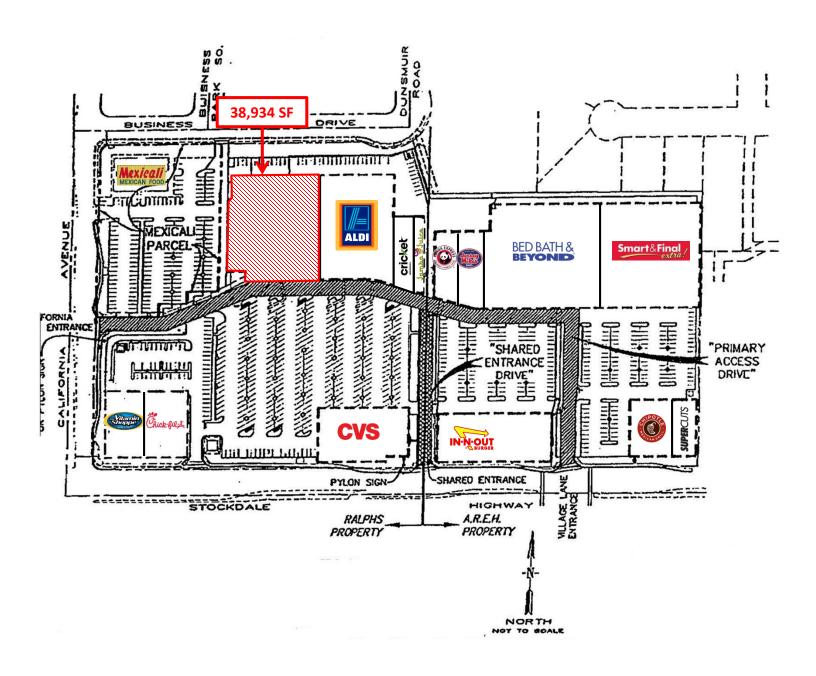

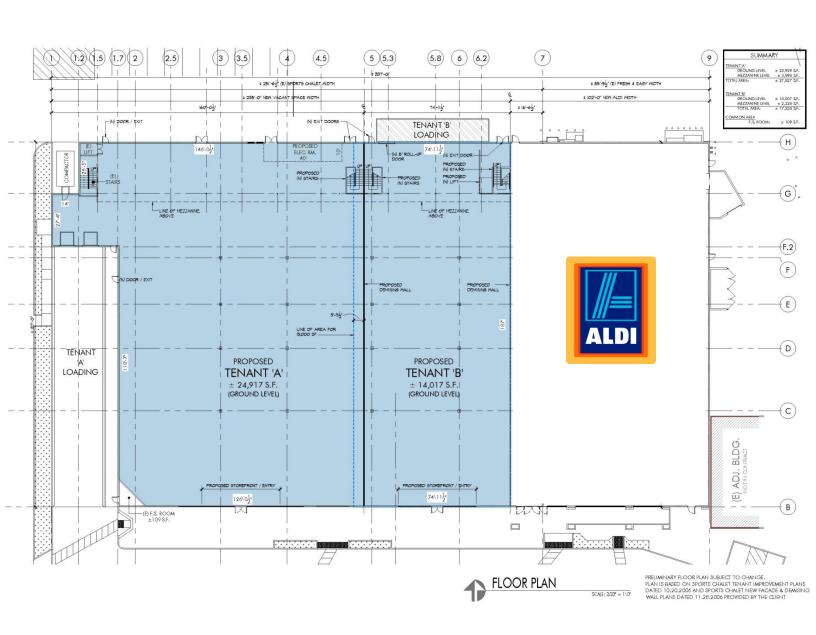
### Site Plan





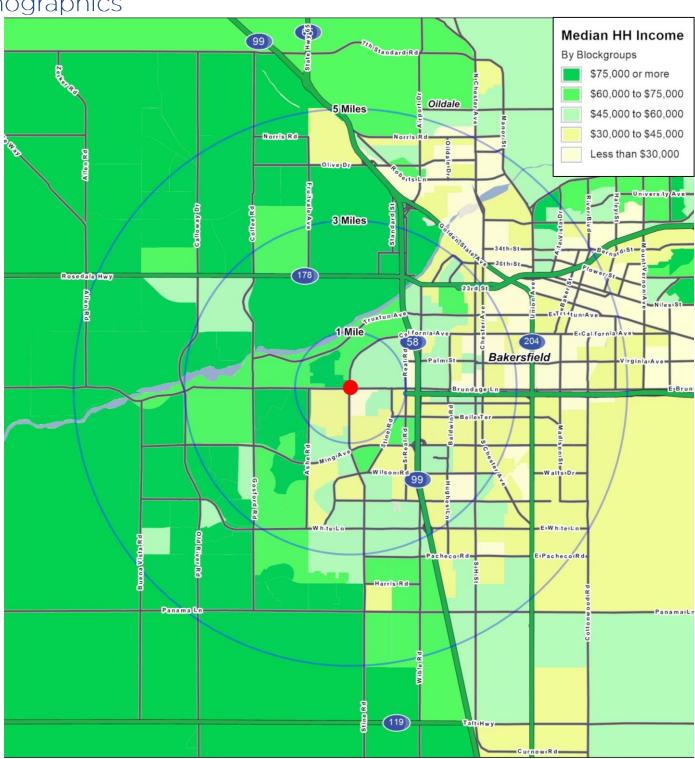
